Motion to approve 2011 January agenda – motion was seconded and approved

Motion to approve 2010 November minutes – motion was seconded and approved

Committee Reports

Tennis Committee

Anne called Courtworks to repair the upper courts. We are also going to get a quote from them about resurfacing the soft courts. Hank is going to recommend two other companies to get the bids and Anne will follow up.

We would like to plan a Tennis Open House/Pavilion Grand Opening during the spring. This could include a member-guest tournament.

Thanks to Hill Smith for putting up a pole to hold up the divider net.

Pool Committee

Winter pool maintenance – this year we have asked Barbara to maintain the pool through the winter. She will check water levels and skimmers. She will also be removing leaves and keeping the pool clean.

Membership Committee

Bob would like to form a new committee for marketing/membership. Lisa & Bradley would co-chair a membership committee.

A motion was made to recruit new members. Any new members who join between February 1 and March 31 will receive \$100 off of their initiation fees. During the month of February (February 1 – 28) we will give a \$250 incentive to current members for each new member that joins by the end of February. (If the member has paid already, they will be reimbursed \$250. If they have not yet paid their dues, they will receive a \$250 credit on their 2011 bill). A direct mailing will be sent at the beginning of February and again in March. The motion was seconded and approved.

We are going to send follow-up letters to those who were in-town guests at the pool this summer with information about joining the club.

Phyllis made a rough draft of a 2011 brochure. She is going to email it to Lisa for proofing, who will then send it to Catie & the board for final approval.

Phyllis is going to price an ad in the South Charlotte Weekly. If it isn't too expensive she will place a Windyrush ad.

Building Committee

The new drawings for the tennis pavilion were completed the first week in January. Plans were submitted to the city on January 5. We are expecting permits between 4 – 8 weeks from now. Once the permits have been obtained, the project should take 4 – 6 weeks to complete.
