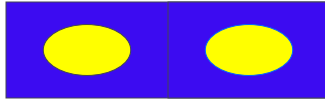

## Poolside Parties

Cost \$50.00

For up to 15 people

Reservations must be made 7 days in advance

If you would like to schedule a birthday party , soccer party, or any other get together event at the pool the cost will be \$50.00 for 15 attendees. If you have more than 15 the fee is \$5.00 per person. Parties include two reserved sitting tables, chairs and one long table. Parties need to be requested at least 7 days in advance and are based on a first come first serve basis. Windyrush will allow the following time slots for parties: Saturday: 1 time slot for morning and 1 for afternoon, Monday through Thursday 2 morning slots and 2 afternoon slots allowed, and Friday 2 morning slots and 1 afternoon slot. If you are planning something special at your party you will need to have approval from the Windyrush Board of Directors. Outside entertainment is not allowed and the pool area cannot be closed off for party games. ## **Old Business:**

We are working on getting a source for music at the pool. Ed will check with Time Warner to see if music is included in the bundle package that we already have.

## **Committee Reports**

### **Finance Committee:**
