Building Committee Update

Trehel is going to rework the space we have available to see if we can lower the cost of the clubhouse/pool house and use the property more efficiently.

Tennis Committee Update

A motion was made to allow Anne & Bob to negotiate a pay increase for Hank. This motion was seconded and approved.

The board would like to see the clinic and lesson rosters so we have an idea of how many adults & children are involved in the program.

Hank can teach after 12:00 pm on Saturdays.

Pool Committee

Barb began a manual for operating procedures at the pool. We will add operating procedures for other areas of the club as well. Catie will work on compiling and editing this information.

We have another request for the use of a party on Saturday evening. **A motion was made to allow the Providence Springs Neighborhood Association Open House (as a marketing event) to use the pool on Saturday, August 27, from 4 – 7 pm for approximately 100 people. The motion was seconded and approved.**

We had the facility sprayed for mosquitoes and bugs today. Ed is going to ask the company to return to spray again next week (\$150)

Bob asked Ken to get a quote for removing the dead limbs and debris in the woods behind the pool.

Office Notes

A motion was made to pro-rate the dues starting September 1. For the last 1/3 of the year the dues would be \$200. The entire initiation fee will be due (the option to pay the initiation over two years will not be permissible). The motion was seconded and approved.

Anne is going to talk to Hank about how to handle the trash pick-up at the pavilion on the weekends.

Tennis pavilion rental policy: \$200 maximum price for 75 people; no more than 35 people upstairs. Contract about picking up trash and cleaning up afterwards. Non-refundable security deposit \$100. Music off at 10 pm; Phyllis will arrange to have gate locked (ending time needs to be established with Phyllis).
